

## **Your Initial Visit to Taylor Chiropractic/Multimed Center**

At Taylor Chiropractic/Multimed we perform a thorough health evaluation on every new patient. This allows us to get to know you as a patient and become familiar with the various aspects of your health, as well as current and past care.

When you initially arrive at our office, you will be asked to fill out basic health history forms to tell us about your current & past health, and your family's health history. You might also have specific paperwork required by your insurance company. Our staff is always available to guide you through this process.

You will then have a consult with the doctor in order that he may obtain specific information regarding your current condition and needs.

Trained first as a portal of entry primary care drugless practitioner and then further trained in the specialty of Neurology, Dr. Taylor will examine you with attention to your particular area of concern, but may also perform additional standard examinations such as vital signs, orthopedic, neurological, and cardiovascular evaluations. In addition the exam would consist of postural evaluation, biomechanical examination and/or muscular, tendon, or ligamentous examination. We pride ourselves on specific diagnosis to allow treatment to target the specific injury or illness. Throughout 27 years of practice, this has allowed us to improve our outcomes with more cost effective quality care.

After the examination; the doctor will briefly review the finding and working diagnosis with you. If further tests are necessary he will explain that to you and an appointment will be set up with the appropriate radiology, laboratory or imaging center. If care can be provided immediately, then that will be rendered on the initial visit for pain relief or to allow you to begin your path toward health.

On your follow up visit, all findings of the examination and any other tests will be reviewed with you along with an outline of the recommended treatment plan. In addition, our staff will coordinate and review your insurance coverage and requirements. As the insured, we always advise patients that they must be familiar with their own insurance and be a participant in the care. We promote a patient centered practice based on the latest research based evidence in coordination with the clinical evidence

from the exam and in consultation with the patient's preferences. If there are any questions, we encourage you to ask the doctor or staff.

Follow up care will be dependent on patient response to care and periodic re-evaluations. Progress is evaluated and then discussed with the patient for updated care plans.
